

# Quick Serger Quilt

## Supply List

### Fabric Requirements:

All fabric should be 100% cotton. Prewashing is recommended. You will need four different light fabrics and four different dark fabrics in the following amounts:

### Lights:

A:  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard

B: 1  $\frac{1}{3}$  yard\*

C:  $\frac{5}{8}$  yard

D:  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard

### Darks:

A: 1 yard (this fabric will also be used for binding.)

B:  $\frac{5}{8}$  yard

C:  $\frac{5}{8}$  yard

D:  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard

Batting: 1 yard (36 x 90 inches) I recommend Warm and White or Warm and Natural cotton batting. You can find this on a bolt in Joanns. It is in the back of the store behind the home dec fabric.

\*The light fabric B must be cut length wise in order to get a piece long enough for this section of the quilt. If you don't mind piecing this section, you will only need  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard.

### Notions required:

Four or five thread serger in good working order

Two new size 90/14 needles for your serger

Four cones of serger thread to match or blend with fabrics

Rotary cutter

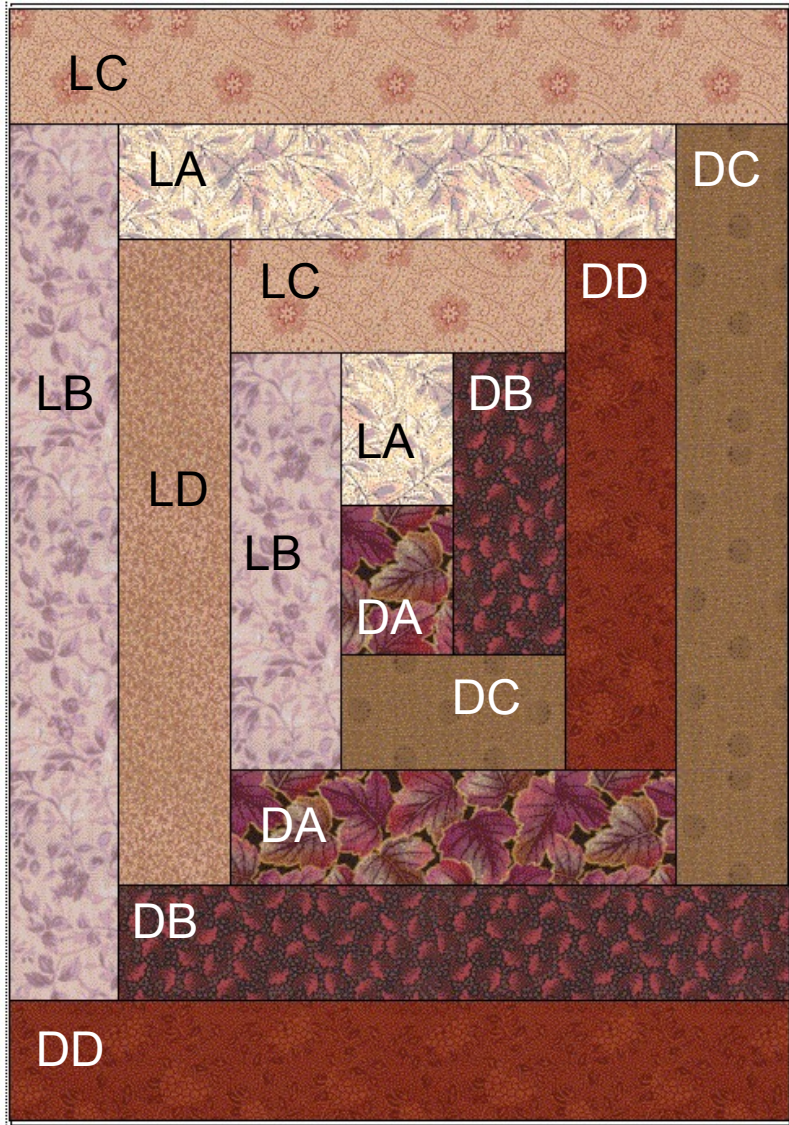
Creative Grid Ruler, 8  $\frac{1}{2}$  by 24

Flower head pins

Binding and hem clips

Square ruler, at least 12.5 by 12.5





**Preparation:**

Prewash all fabric.

Light Color A : cut two strips, 6 ½ inches by the Width of the Fabric. (fabric should be at least 42” wide.)  
Label these LA .

Do not cut Light Color B

Light Color C : cut three strips, 6 ½ inches by WoF . Label these LC .

Light Color D : cut two strips 6 ½ inches by WoF . Label these LD .

Dark Color A : cut two strips 6 ½ inches by WoF . Label these DA . Bring the rest of fabric DA to class so you may cut your binding.

Dark Color B : cut three strips 6 ½ inches by WoF . Label these DB .

Dark Color C : cut three strips 6 ½ inches by WoF . Label these DC .

Dark Color D : cut four strips 6 ½ inches by WoF . Label these DD .

Batting: Cut five strips, 6 ½ inches wide by 90 inches.
